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




Average Annual Growth in GRP/GDP






Job Change by Sector Washington MSA








Federal Spending in the Washington Core Area



Fiscal Years 1980-2022





15 Largest Job Markets Job Change





Annual Job Change District of Columbia (2012-2022)








Job Change by Sector District of Columbia



Unemployment Rates in the WMSA By Sub-State Area




